ADDITIONAL SECURITY GUIDELINES ON HOW TO STAY SAFE AND SECURE DURING THE 2023 GENERAL ELECTION

Further to the security advisory given by the High Commission earlier, some additional points for observance during elections are given below. Some important points have been reiterated.

- a. Refrain from attending Political gathering and do not get involved in Political discussions, especially in public places.
- b. Avoid showing support for any Political Party. Remain neutral and avoid wearing Political campaign shirts or materials.
- c. Endeavor to listen to the news on radio particularly the FM stations and be mindful of fake news.
- d. Stock your house or residence with all basic needs (food, water and medications), and other necessities i.e. fuel and oil for your generators and avoid going out during the election period.
- e. Stay at home and if you happen to be out on essential duty or activity, please get back home on time.
- f. Don't keep late nights during the election period.
- g. Do not criticize any politician.
- h. Even with ties and affiliation or kingship, neutrality is the key for safety amongst neighbours, DO NOT over trust anyone.
- j. Don't move or keep too much cash.
- k. Ensure that your car central lock is activated when driving. As a precaution, cancel all appointments if not essential during the period, take a break.
- I. Stay clear from crowds or other groups of people particularly unidentified crowds.
- m. Also note that even victory celebrations have a tendency of violence. Please do not participate in any, unless it is formal, and security guaranteed.

Finally, adhere to all security advisories and encourage other to do so.
