4th Edition of the Indo-Africa ICT Expo 2018, Lagos (22-23 May 2018):



Telecom Equipment and Services Export Promotion Council (TEPC) of India along with the High Commission of India, Abuja and the Ministry of Communications of Federal Republic of Nigeria has launched the 4th Edition of Indo-Africa ICT Expo 2018 in conjunction with IT and Telecom Summit, on 22 May 2018 at the Eko Hotels and Convention Centre in Lagos, Nigeria. The Nigerian Minister of Communications, H.E. Mr. Abdur-Raheem Adebayo Shittu was the chief guest at the event. In his opening remarks he expressed Nigeria's readiness to partner with India for streamlining the ICT sector in Nigeria, and enhancing its ability to catalyze and sustain socioeconomic development critical to Nigeria's vision of becoming a top 20 economy by the year 2020.
